

The Town of Plympton, MA Police Department is accepting applications for the position of Full-Time Career Police Officer. Applicants must be full-time academy trained through the Massachusetts Police Training Committee. Out-of-state applicants who have completed a full-time police officer training academy may apply if their academy training is recognized by the Massachusetts Police Training Committee. Minimum requirements include the following: must be 22-years-old, possess a High School diploma (60 college credits from an accredited College/University or 2 years active duty in any Armed Services of the United States of America) is preferred, be a United States citizen, possess a valid driver's license.

Successful applicants must pass a physical and psychological examination, a thorough background investigation and also successfully complete the state Physical Ability Test.
